

Final Forms

Bishop Fenwick High School Athletic Department uses Final Forms, an online data management service for athletic participation forms and more. Parents are able to register information just once and Final Forms stores and updates the data, which makes the annual registration process for athletic participation quick and easy. Once information is verified, both parents and student athletes will electronically sign the required forms and updates are made as needed for future participation. Final Forms are **REQUIRED** for any student that will be participating in BFHS athletics. **Physical Forms will still need to be printed off and signed by your doctor, however only pages 5 and 6 are required to be physically turned into the <u>Athletic Office</u>. You will need to print this directly from Final Forms.**

The 'Sudden Cardiac Arrest Awareness' form is now included in Final Forms for Parents and Athletes. The form includes:

Pay to Participate Fees

All play to participate fees will be \$400 each season per sport.

Athletic Fees and Refunds:

Athletic&BandParticipationfeesarerequiredforstudentathletesandbandmembers to participate in our programs. Participation fees will be billed via the FACTS billing program as follows: Fall participation will have an October payment; Winter participation will have a January payment; Spring participation will have an April payment.

Refunding Fees - Guidelines and Procedures

- If a student is cut from a sport or quits prior to the first contest or performance (Band), the school will refund the full amount of Athletic Participation Fee.
- If a student quits an activity after the first contest or performance (band), is removed from the activity for disciplinary reasons or becomes academically ineligible after the first contest, there will be no refund.
- If a student moves out of the district before the midpoint of the season, there will be a 50% refund unless the student has been involved in a previous extracurricular activity that year. If a student moves out of the district after the midpoint of the season, there will be no refund.
- If a student experiences a season ending injury before the midpoint of the season, there will be a 50% refund if the student is not involved in any other extracurricular activity during the school year. If a student receives a season ending injury after the midpoint of the season, there will be no refund.
- All refund requests must be submitted to the BFAthletic Office (AD)
